Re: Vehicle Use

On May 7, 2008, Chief State's Attorney Kevin Kane issued a memo asking all Division of Criminal Justice employees with state assigned vehicles to make every effort to assist with the Governor's request to reduce fuel consumption by 10% this fiscal year and 25% next fiscal year.

The Police Inspectors Council, CSEA SEIU Local 2001, is willing to cooperate with the Division of Criminal Justice to assist where we can. We are aware that all of our members are finding ways to conserve fuel but here are some additional suggestions:

- ✓ Decrease your speed when driving.
- ✓ Avoid quick starts and sudden stops.
- ✓ Keep the vehicles properly maintained.
- ✓ Keep the vehicle's tires properly inflated.
- ✓ Use air conditioning sparingly.
- ✓ Plan field work wisely. When possible, consolidate investigation field work.
- ✓ If a co-worker has investigation work in the same area where you are going, travel together.

Overall, drive conservatively and wisely. If anyone has additional helpful suggestions to conserve fuel consumption, please share your ideas with other members.
