

Tell Region 8's School Board: Don't Waste Education Resources

By a vote of 6 to 4, the **Regional School District Number 8's Board of Education rejected a tentative agreement on a successor contract** for the assistant bookkeeper, maintenance workers, office staff, custodians, and paraprofessionals who work in RHAM Middle and High Schools. These non-certified employees urge taxpayers in Andover, Hebron and Marlborough to demand their elected officials **support a fair contract** and **make better choices**.

Unless the public speaks out, the dispute will go to arbitration, just like earlier this year when school officials were unable to reach an agreement with the district's teachers. **Let's not let them repeat that costly mistake again.**
