



VERNON/ROCKVILLE CARRIAGE HOUSE VETS DONATIONS

After some neighborhood opposition, seven military veterans moved into newly renovated apartments at One Ellington Avenue in Rockville last March. The Town of Vernon had previously issued a zoning permit, approved by the Town attorney, for its reconfiguration and renovation into the seven one-bedroom apartments. Veterans living in the apartments have been diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. This is a common disorder found in those who have experienced the trauma of war on a first hand basis. The Chrysalis Center of Hartford arranged to provide case management services for the Veterans, which included counseling, life skills and interface with VA services.

A fund has been opened at Rockville Bank to receive donations for the Carriage House Vets. Polly and Carl Schaefer and myself have established an agreement with the Chrysalis Center for them to manage the fund and purchase the furniture and household goods for the Vets.
