Dear Fellow Member,

On July 22, 2011, leaders of the unions in the State Employees Bargaining Agent Coalition (SEBAC) voted to recommend a tentative agreement (TA) with the Malloy Administration that protects jobs and preserves benefits. This followed the conclusion of an intensive week of discussions on the role of Connecticut's state workforce in the larger debate over budget deficits, revenue shortfalls, and public sector unions.

The ratification vote on the agreement for the **Supervising Judicial Marshals** unit is scheduled for:

When: Monday, August 15, 2011

Where: CSEA SEIU Local 2001 Headquarters,

SJM members will cast a single ballot to either approve or reject both the SEBAC 2011 tentative agreement (TA), and an extension on their individual bargaining unit's contract, which is included here. The SEBAC tentative agreement covers and extends healthcare and retirement security benefits through **June 30, 2022**. Individual contracts would be extended through **June 30, 2016**.

If you will be out of state or medically unable to come to CSEA SEIU Local 2001 Headquarters on August 15, 2011 you should request an absentee ballot as soon as possible. Contact Union Administrative Director Mike Nortz at mnortz@csea760.com to request an electronic absentee ballot. In the email request, you must provide your state employee id number, name, and current home address. You will then be sent an authentication code that will be necessary to cast your absentee ballot a secure website. All electronic absentee ballots must be submitted online on or before **August 15**.

The Executive Committee of the Supervising Judicial Marshal Council is recommending that our members vote to approve ratification of the SEBAC TA and the extension of their bargaining unit contract. While never easy to concede future gains, it is always important to preserve past protections. This agreement does that.
