

CHAPTER 9
REPORT OF MEETING
April 12, 2011

The April 12, 2011 meeting of CSEA Chapter 9 was opened by Mr. Peter Macher at 12:00 P.M. Approximately 45 members were present for the meeting. A sign in sheet is on file with the secretary.

The Unions and Governor Malloy have met. Discussions have taken place about the budget and possible concessions from state employees. No other information is available at this time.

The Governor can reduce staff by 5% each year without legislative approval.

Dave Glidden, a staff rep for the union, has resigned.

SEIU wants to take \$200,000.00 from our budget for the Dream Fund.

If any employee gets a layoff notice and has been laid off in the past, contact a union steward.

The P-4 Council summer picnic is July 15, 2011 at the Farmington Club. Cost is \$25 after council discounts.

Orientation for new employees by the union is being kept to 1 hour maximum, which the union disagrees with and will take this issue to the labor board.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:30 P.M.
